1. Confirm Your Mailing Address and Phone

Before you do anything else, please send us an email with your:

- 1. Complete postal mailing address and
- 2. Your best phone number

...immediately. Send it to support@acxmasterclass.com.

We ask you for this as you may have used a billing address that is different from your mailing address when you registered for class, and we want to make sure you get your welcome package. You'll be receiving something you'll need for the class and your audiobook recording set up.

2. Register on the ACXMasterClass.com Website

Now that you've joined the course, you'll need access to the huge repository of content that the class offers. We release all of that material across the four weeks of the class via the course's website.

To do that, you'll need to complete registration for an account on the **ACXMasterclass.com website**. Here's how that works:

• Sometime during the week before the first class (if you haven't already), you'll be getting an email from:

WordPress - wordpress@acxmasterclass.com (not from Dan or me)

...with the subject line:

[ACX Master Class] Login Details

...that gives you your assigned username (usually a version of your email address) and a long link to log in to the site for the first time and **choose your password**.

(If you don't see that message in your inbox, please check your spam/junk/update/promo/social folders. HOTMAIL USERS: please check your quarantined email on the Hotmail servers, and mark us as a trusted sender.)

- Click the link in that message to log in to our site.
- **Change your password** to whatever you'd like. Once you've selected a password, you'll see a screen that says:

Your password has been reset. Log in.

Log in again with your chosen password, and you should be taken directly to a
very important page: the ACX Master Class Resource page (more on that in the
next section of this Guide). If not, just click on the Resources link on the site's
menu bar.

On the Resources page, you'll find a video waiting for you (there will be dozens there by the time the class wraps up, as well as PDF files, videos and MP3 files). That video that shows you how to change your password if you didn't when you first logged in:

If you ever need to change your password, watch that video to learn how.

3. Finding Course Materials: The Resource Page

Now that you're logged in with your chosen password, you should be taken directly to a very important page: **the ACX Master Class Resource page**. If not, just click on the **Resources** link on the site's menu bar.

This is a very important page: it's where you'll be seeing new content appear on that page all throughout the course, so **bookmark that page**. It's the page you'll likely visit most often on the ACXMasterClass.com website!

4. Attending Our Final Session on Zoom

All of the course material, from the classes to the Q&As to the individual tutorials we share, **is recorded**. And it's available to you 24/7, once it's released. Some of it is in PDF format, some of it is video, and some of it is audio. **There are no live Zoom sessions** to rush off too...

...until the week after class is over. Then, we do a live Zoom call where you can ask any questions you want about the course and its content.

In case you've managed to avoid Zoom for all these years, we have a tutorial on how to join it, and we'll email you access information on that before the sessions begin.

What time will that live session start? How long will it run?

We start each session promptly at 6:00 PM PACIFIC TIME. The sessions can go for a couple of hours or more, and are followed with the release of new material on the Resource page, much of which walks you step-by-step through concepts and processes we introduce in the class sessions.

What if I miss the session? Will it be recorded?

No worries. It will be recorded, and you'll be given an opportunity to send it questions ahead of time via email if you can't attend. We will then release the recordings the next morning for anyone who'd like to review the session, or who couldn't attend the live session.

5. Get Help (Part 1): Private Account Help via Email

Now that you're inside the website, you'll want to know what to do when you need help.

There are **three ways** you can get help from our team and from your fellow classmates.

- 1. via our support email address
- 2. our course's private Facebook group
- 3. our on-site Mastermind group

We'll look at those last two in the next sections. It's really important that you understand how they are all used.

You might be tempted to email Dan or David via their personal email addresses to ask questions about the course.

DON'T DO THAT.

If you do, all you'll get is a reply reminding you not to.

We have a **dedicated support email address** that gets your messages and then sends them to everyone on our team so any of us can help you. And it's simple. Here it is:

support@acxmasterclass.com

That's nice and big, so you don't miss it. **Please immediately add that address to your email system's address book or contacts list.** When you do, something <u>magical</u>

happens: that address is <u>whitelisted</u>, meaning email coming to you from that address will more likely end up in your inbox, rather than in your spam or junk folder.

Use our support email address for any personal inquiries about your class membership, your account, login/password information, naming and email usage on Facebook, etc. **DON'T USE THIS EMAIL ADDRESS TO ASK QUESTIONS ABOUT THE COURSE CONTENT.** For that, you want to use the private Facebook group, and/or the on-site Mastermind group, which we'll look at next.

6. Get Help (Part 2): The Private Facebook Group

To review, the support email address is ONLY for private, account related help. But what about help with the course? How do we bat things back and forth?

For help with the coursework, and for discussion with us and with your fellow students in the course, there are two options for you. You can join one or the other, or both:

- 1. The 2022 ACX Master Class private Facebook group
- 2. The 2022 ACXMasterClass.com on-site Mastermind group

Why are there two different discussion groups? Because in recent years, we've noticed that some students did not want to be on Facebook, for various reasons. We created the Mastermind as a second option.

This section is all about our private **Facebook** group. We'll talk about the **Mastermind** group in the next section. And NOTE: any announcements we make to the class will be posted in both the Facebook group AND the on-site Mastermind group.

You're invited to **join your class' private Facebook mastermind group**. Once you get into the private Facebook mastermind group for the class, you'll post questions about the curriculum and content there, so everyone can see and benefit from the answers (and even chime in if they know - wisdom of the tribe). You'll also discuss issues around the world of audiobooks, offer opinions and respectful dialog, and you'll be able to get help from our team and all the students in the class.

The Facebook group is where you should post questions first, unless they are of a personal nature about your account or something private. Then, as we noted, you use the support email address and the team will help you.

How To Join Our Class's Facebook Group

- 1. Make sure you are logged into Facebook.
- 2. Go to https://www.facebook.com/groups/acxmc2022hsmastermind . (If for some reason that link doesn't work, try copying & pasting into the address bar of your Web browser.)
- 3. Tap on the Join Group button near the top of the page. It looks like this:



4. After Facebook notifies us that you've asked to join the group, we'll approve your request...and voila! You're in the private Facebook Group.

Note: Only individual Facebook accounts (aka "profiles") can join the group. That means a Facebook page cannot join. (A Facebook page = Business Page, Fan Page, etc.)

In the unlikely event you are unable to go directly to the Mastermind Group, double check to confirm that you are already logged in and you're logged in under your own personal account. (Some people have more than one account.)

Send an email to supportacxmasterclass.com (yes!) and be sure to tell us what steps you've taken, precisely what has happened when you've tried to get to the group's page, etc. Don't worry; if you're a Facebook member, we'll get you into the Mastermind Group!

Once in, please introduce yourself to us and to your fellow classmates.

IMPORTANT

Just so you know, **FACEBOOK DOES NOT ALLOW PAGES TO BE MEMBERS OF SECRET GROUPS.** Please don't ask - there's nothing we can do to change their rules. You should become a member via your profile.

What if you're not on Facebook, or you don't like Facebook?

We've got you covered two ways (one is with our on-site Mastermind group, covered in the next section). We also have an explanation Dan put together on how to join Facebook and create a profile just for this class, and **without giving Facebook any personal information** they can use or sell. You'll find that on the Resources page.

Now, let's talk about some **very simple rules** that we expect all students and graduates to follow when it comes to using the Facebook group.

Rules of the Facebook Group

Our rules of behavior inside the private Facebook mastermind discussion group are simple. They revolve around giving help and getting help, and being respectful of everyone in the group.

To be a member of the Group is a privilege associated with the ACX Master Class, and if you don't follow the rules, you'll lose these valuable benefits:

- → Ask for help with course material
- → Ask for help with a particular ACX audiobook problem (including related technical challenges)
- → Offer help to others who are experiencing an ACX audiobook-related problem

- → Share your progress (e.g., "here's the recording booth I built") with your colleagues
- → Share your audiobook successes with your colleagues
- → Celebrate the successes of other group members.

It is NOT the place to:

- → post questions or problems related to your class account (e.g., "I can't log in"). You now know that those should be handled by sending an email to support@ACXMasterClass.com.
- → post a message intended solely for David or for Dan.
- → post ANY outside links (other than to your own newly published audiobook)
- → promote some entity (person, product, etc.) or -- as a way of getting around the "no outside links" rule -- telling people to Google the name or other search terms to locate them
- → tell everyone what some other group is arguing about or advising
- → tell everyone what some outside "expert" (some of whom are tremendously knowledgeable, while some others should be avoided at all costs) says
- → make personal posts that aren't directly related to the mission of the group (what you're doing this evening, where you're going tomorrow, your vacation plans, etc.)
- → invite others to PM you if they're interested in some unrelated activity you're involved in.

The "don't" list really isn't as formidable as it appears. Really.

Please follow those rules - they've been really helpful over the years in keeping our online culture one of "be nice, be respectful, be helpful."

7. Get Help (Part 3): The On-Site Mastermind

The Mastermind group is your second option for help with the coursework. You access it, not on Facebook, but on the ACXMasterClass.com site. And its rules of conduct are exactly the same. And, yes, **you can be members of both** if you like.

And you're already a member of **your class' private Mastermind group**.

Accessing the Mastermind Group

Log in to the ACXMasterClass.com site (if you're not logged in already) and click on the **Mastermind** link at the top of the **Resources** page, and you're in! You'll start by reading the rules and agreeing to them. Not surprisingly, the rules are exactly the same as the rules for the Facebook group. **Once in, please introduce yourself** to us and to your fellow classmates.

And, like the Facebook group, the Mastermind group is where you can post questions about the curriculum and content, discuss issues around the world of audiobooks, offer opinions and respectful dialog, and you'll be able to get help from our team and all the students in the class.

Do not post questions of a personal nature about your account or something private. Then, as we noted, you use the support email address and the team will help you.

8. The Detailed Curriculum of Course Content

One of the most common things that happen is that students get ready for what's coming, and it doesn't necessarily follow their expectations: as an example, they might be itching to know exactly what gear to get, but well before we've given them the underlying foundation of why they do or don't need certain items.

So, we want to make sure you know what's coming. We've created a detailed schedule of what will be taught when, one that might look familiar as it was displayed on the registration page you completed when you joined the course.

Please, if you haven't already, download and review that PDF file before class begins, so you know when we will be teaching what content.

9. What's Ahead

Once you get everything that precedes this taken care of, there are a few details we need to share with you so that you know what to expect once class begins. As the weeks go by, you'll get more and more information, released in a carefully designed flow so as not to overwhelm you. Here's what you will see each day:

- Every **Monday**, you'll get an email that tells you what's new for that week, including the Study Guide for that week, access information for the live Zoom session for that night, and a reminder about the new material for the week you'll find added to your class Resources page. Watch for it from us!
- Every **Tuesday** morning, you'll get an email that gives you bonus content for that week's class, access to the class recording for that week, and more new material for the week you'll find added to your class Resources page.
- You might also get material sent to you on Wednesday. It depends on the week.
- Every **Thursday** morning, you'll get even more instructional content that ties into that week's course content.
- And then every **Friday** morning, you'll get an email that gives you the info on how to access the recordings of that week's Q & A Zoom session, plus any extra bonus content for that week.

TIP: You might want to create a filter and a label for the emails and other information you're going to be getting over the next several weeks. You can set
